

Essential Adriatic (Dubrovnik – Trogir – Split – Zadar - Zagreb) 5 days – 4 nights



Dubrovnik with its cultural heritage and Franciscan Monastery leaves you breathless. After visiting Dubrovnik, the tour takes you to Split, which is known for Diocletian's Palace. The tour continues to Renaissance Trogir and Zadar, where we visit the magical church of Sv. Donat, and carries on to a modern and charming Zagreb.

Dubrovnik, a city of unique political and cultural history of the centuries-old Dubrovnik Republic emerged from the ruins of the ancient Epidaurum. Under the protection of St. Blaise, it is one of the most attractive cities in the Mediterranean. Experience the harmony between man and architecture, visiting one of Europe's oldest pharmacies, the Rector's Palace and the Cathedral.

Split is an urban cultural center of Dalmatia that has existed for 1700 years, and combines a variety of archaeological, historical and cultural monuments, among which is a special palace selected as the



home of the Emperor Diocletian born in nearby Salona. The warm Mediterranean temper and urban rhythm of the city will reveal many stories.



Zadar, antique Iadera of St. Donat whose waterfront is the place of human ideas and skills with the energy of the sea, waves, tides and with beautiful installation Greeting to the Sun. The city lies surrounded by five national parks. Do not miss the opportunity to visit them.

Zagreb, placed in the heart of Europe with highlights like the Gothic cathedral, the picturesque market Dolac, Upper Town with the church of St. Mark's and the shortest funicular in the world-Uspinjača will leave you speechless.



ITINERARY

D1 Sunday / DUBROVNIK – Arrival

Upon arrival at Dubrovnik Airport, transfer to hotel for dinner and overnight.

D2 Monday / DUBROVNIK – SPLIT

Morning sightseeing tour of Dubrovnik, included in UNESCO's List of World Cultural Heritage. You will visit the Franciscan Monastery with Europe's third oldest pharmacy, the Rector's Palace and the Cathedral. Afternoon departure for Split, driving along the Adriatic Coast and the Neretva River Delta. Dinner and overnight in Split.

D3 Tuesday / SPLIT – TROGIR – ZADAR

Morning sightseeing tour of Split, covering the Diocletian's Palace on the UNESCO's List of World Cultural Heritage, with the Peristyle, the Jupiter's Temple and the Cathedral. Departure for Trogir, a picturesque mediaeval town where we visit the Cathedral of St. Lawrence. Continuation to Zadar, dinner and overnight.

D4 Wednesday / ZADAR – ZAGREB

Morning sightseeing tour of Zadar, including the Roman Forum and St. Donatus Church, magnificent monument of Romanesque architecture. Afternoon departure for Zagreb, the capital of Croatia. Dinner and overnight in Zagreb.

D5 Thursday / ZAGREB – Departure

Morning city tour of Zagreb, including the fortified Upper Town, the city's historical center, St. Mark's Church with its multicolored roof, the Cathedral, the Croatian National Theatre and the University. Transfer to Zagreb Airport for your departure flight.
